













Introduction to the Lighthouse Albums "NETHERLANDS" (Country No. 12)

Pages are all loose leaf and consist of strong quality HEAVY BOND PAPER. The strong side binder ensures that the pages keep lying flat when the album is opened. The binder is of the spring-book type and is easily manipulated as shown in the following diagrams:



To remove pages from the binder, slide insert grid leaves with right hand and draw book front cover of binder until it touches the edge of the page. To close, slide cover of book cover closed until the binder is closed again.

Supplements are published annually in May/June. When ordering supplements, enter **N** (= Nederland, German word for **Supplement**, number of album, indicate REGULAR or SPRING-BOOK type).

Blank Pages can be had from your dealer by the following reference numbers:

"Lighthouses No. 12" and "Niederlande" or top.
