The International Zone of Tangier was incorporated into Spanish Morocco in October of 1940 and the stamps of Spanish Morocco were used until the International Status was re-established after the war. These stamps were used without overprint with values in pesetas and centimos, or they were surcharged with new denominations in FRANCOS. The surcharges were typographed, but the old values were blotted out by hand, either as an afterthought or to avoid the need for multiple plates. Stamps of Spanish Morocco used in Tangier during this period can only be identified by the cancel or when on document. The surcharged stamps were subsequently used, with a handstamped or printed TANGER added, when the International Zone was re-established.

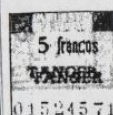

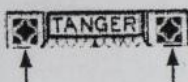
